**Cost: A \$10.00 4-H fee and \$2.00 insurance fee are due at meeting**



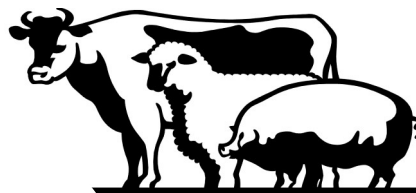
